



**PUBLIC NOTICE-CUSTOMERS OF
MONTGOMERY CITY PWS FAILURE TO MEET
Radionuclides MONITORING
REQUIREMENTS FOR DRINKING WATER**

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During January 01, 2014 to December 31, 2019, we did not monitor or test as required and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time. Water samples are taken on a month basis. All water testing standards were met with exception of radionuclides.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the monitoring required by the system and the monitoring completed by the system.
